

### <u>UPDATED COVID GUIDELINES</u> EFFECTIVE AUGUST 15, 2021

- In concert with the other Bishops in Pennsylvania, the obligation to attend Mass on weekends and Holy Days is returning effective August 15th.
- Effective the week of August 16th, all daily Masses will be held in Church.
- There are no longer any seating or capacity restrictions in the Church. All pews are open again and <u>reservations are no longer needed</u> for any Mass!
- Ushers are now required to wear a facemask when greeting parishioners and when taking up the collection. Masks are also required for the priest, deacon or Eucharistic Minister at the distribution of Communion. Face masks are not required for anyone else on diocesan property. Those who wish to continue to wear one are free to do so.
- The Exchange of the Sign of Peace is not permitted.
- With the exception of these items, most other liturgical restrictions are relaxed/eliminated.

### THE PRO-LIFE CORNER

"They Shoot Horses, Don't They" - A 1969 film that included a "mercy killing." Euthanasia, (Catholic Catechism: "an action or omission that, by itself or by intention, causes a person's death in order to avoid suffering") is at the other end of the culture of death. It is usually reserved for the elderly or for those who no longer have the ability to be useful to society.

Euthanasia is not the same as forgoing extraordinary or disproportionate means, which may only prolong life with no prospects of improvement. In this situation, food, water, and painkillers are provided.

Proponents of Euthanasia, for example the Hemlock Society and physician assisted suicide groups, often present their arguments in emotional terms with the emphasis on the patient's suffering.



Come and learn more about this wonderful prayer form and tradition. Most of our time together will be spent exploring the history and present experience of celebrating the Liturgy of the Hours (Divine Office). From that rhythm of prayer often flows Lectio Divina (sacred reading), especially when the first part of the Office, Vigils (Office of Readings), is celebrated in the dark of night.

PRESENTER: Brother Bernard Seif, SMC, EdD, DNM, ABBHP is a Christian monk in the Roman Catholic and Salesian traditions and a clinical psychologist board certified in behavioral medicine and behavioral health practice. He also is educated in natural health modalities, specializing in Chinese medicine with sub-specialties in Medical Qigong and Chinese medicinal herbs.

### GODPARENT/SPONSOR ELIGIBILITY FORMS

In order to act as a godparent for Baptism or a Sponsor for Confirmation, one must be a Catholic in good standing. Specifically this means Mass attendance every Sunday (Exodus 20:8), striving to live the moral precepts of the Church, and if married, a valid marriage in the Catholic Church.

#### THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

is celebrated on Sunday at Noon. If you are a parishioner and would like to schedule a Baptism, please contact the Parish Office. Prior to the baptism, parents must attend a Baptism Preparation Class which is designed to instruct the parents about the teachings of the church regarding Baptism, and to offer assistance in the spiritual preparation for their child's reception of the first of the Sacraments of the Church.

#### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Parishioners who are contemplating the Sacrament of Matrimony should contact the Pastor and mutually agree upon a date at least a year prior to the Wedding. The Church takes the preparation for the Sacrament of Matrimony very seriously, and requires completion of the Diocesan Marriage Preparation Program six months before the wedding. The normative time for weddings is Saturday between 10:00 AM and 1:30 PM. Weddings are not celebrated on major holidays, nor on the first weekend of June in deference to Ordination of Priests each year at that time. Either the Bride or the Groom must be a practicing member of Sacred Heart Parish in order to request a wedding date.

### COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND

A Priest or Deacon will visit monthly. Extraordinary Ministers visit those who wish to receive more often. Always notify us about the homebound parishioners who wish to be visited.

### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS


