

#### 20th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME AUGUST 20TH

First Reading—Thus says the LORD: Observe what is right, do what is just; for my salvation is about to come, my justice, about to be revealed. The foreigners who join themselves to the LORD, ministering to him, loving the name of the LORD, and becoming his servants—all who keep the sabbath free from profanation and hold to my covenant, them I will bring to my holy mountain and make joyful in my house of prayer; their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be acceptable on my altar, for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples. (Is 56:1, 6-7)

# <u>Psalm</u>-"O God, let all the nations praise you!" (Ps 67:2-3, 5,6,8)

Second Reading—Brothers and sisters: I am speaking to you Gentiles. Inasmuch as I am the apostle to the Gentiles, I glory in my ministry in order to make my race jealous and thus save some of them. For if their rejection is the reconciliation of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead? For the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable. Just as you once disobeyed God but have now received mercy because of their disobedience, so they have now disobeyed in order that, by virtue of the mercy shown to you, they too may now receive mercy. The performance is at 11:00am, with the bus departing Sacred Heart Church at 8:00am.


After the show, there will be a meal stop in Lancaster; location to be determined (please note that the cost of the meal is NOT included in the price of the ticket).

#### CORAL MIRACLE CHURCH, MAUI, HAWAII

When you stop at the Wailua overlooks on the road to Hana, you will see a church. This small church is known to locals as Coral Miracle Church. In 1860 residents planned

to build a church out of lava rock, but needed a bonding agent. Although coral would serve, harvesting it from the ocean was difficult, dangerous and time-consuming, Fearing that building was not going to commence, a miracle happened. A sudden great storm came and washed a massive amount of coral torn from the reef onto the nearby beach and when the building was finished a second storm washed what coral was left back into the ocean. The official name of the church may have been St. Gabriel's, but it was forever known to the locals as Coral Miracle Church.

"I was blessed to be in this little church. I remember the whole church was adorned with trinkets and flowers in honor of our Blessed Mother. While there, we were amazed when reading on how the church was built with the help of nature and God's Blessing. It breaks my heart to see it gone by fire but I understand it was built with the help of nature and nature took it back. I believe God has blessed all who had the chance to walk into this little church and feel the presence of Our Blessed Mary and God's wondrous gift of nature. The peacefulness of the island was magical but the Coral Miracle Church will always be one of God's miracles..... One I will never forget...." --Karen Shimko

#### **PRO-LIFE CORNER**

As a follow-up to my last homily. Please try to take the time to read Pope Paul VI's encyclical Humanae Vitae, (Of Human Life). You can access it online or order a copy. It is only 15 pages long, and only takes about 15 minutes to read.

If you were not at my last homily, Bishop Schlert sent an email to all of the Priests and Deacons to preach on Humanae Vitae to acknowledge its 55th year anniversary. The essence of the encyclical was that Catholics should not use the newly released birth control pill as a means of artificial regulating birth. The Pope outlines the reasons and complexities of his decision.

The prophetic nature and accuracy of the encyclical, in view of our present cultural moral confusion, is well worth the read.

#### GODPARENT/SPONSOR ELIGIBILITY FORMS

In order to act as a godparent for Baptism or a Sponsor for Confirmation, one must be a Catholic in good standing. Specifically this means Mass attendance every Sunday (Exodus 20:8), striving to live the moral precepts of the Church, and if married, a valid marriage in the Catholic Church.

#### THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

is celebrated on Sunday at Noon. If you are a parishioner and would like to schedule a Baptism, please contact the Parish Office. Prior to the baptism, parents must attend a Baptism Preparation Class which is designed to instruct the parents about the teachings of the church regarding Baptism, and to offer assistance in the spiritual preparation for their child's reception of the first of the Sacraments of the Church.

#### **SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE**

Parishioners who are contemplating the Sacrament of Matrimony should contact the Pastor and mutually agree upon a date at least a year prior to the Wedding. The Church takes the preparation for the Sacrament of Matrimony very seriously, and requires completion of the Diocesan Marriage Preparation Program six months before the wedding. The normative time for weddings is Saturday between 10:00 AM and 1:30 PM. Weddings are not celebrated on major holidays, nor on the first weekend of June in deference to Ordination of Priests each year at that time. Either the Bride or the Groom must be a practicing member of Sacred Heart Parish in order to request a wedding date.

#### COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND

A Priest or Deacon will visit monthly. Extraordinary Ministers visit those who wish to receive more often. Always notify us about the homebound parishioners who wish to be visited.

#### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

#### **CONSOLATION MINISTRY**


